

## IMPORTANT NOTES

- This summer, participants who register before May 24th will be eligible for a weekly drawing to win an iPod Nano! There will be a drawing at noon every Friday. Register early—for your chance to win!
- All classes meet Monday through Friday except week one in which classes meet from Tuesday July 6th through SATURDAY, July 10. All one-week classes meet one evening as specified.
- Topics courses may be repeated for credit with different content for a maximum of 6 credits.
- The maximum number of credits that may be earned toward a degree at CCSU during one five-week term is eight. There is no limit on the number of credits one may take independent of a degree program.
- Some courses may require the purchase of texts or other materials. Requirements will be announced on the website or on the first day of classes.
- All classes will meet in Welte Hall. Specific room numbers will be posted at the entrance of Welte Hall and outside the SMI office (Welte, Room 209).
- Please park in student parking lots, especially the student lot behind the Student Center, including the parking garage. Those staying in the dorm may park in the dorm lots.
